

Uniform Policy

AI Madina International Kindergarten

Aims and Objectives

Our school uniform policy is based on the notion that a school uniform promotes a sense of pride in the school, looks smart and is practical and makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance.

Children in KG 1 and KG-2 are required to wear the uniform to school at all times. A high standard of personal appearance is expected of all students. Students arriving at school in non-uniform clothing will be sent to the school office to ring home for a change of clothing to be brought to the school.

Our Uniform requirements

Boys

- Navy blue trousers
- White polo T shirt with navy blue stripe in collar and cuff and Al Madina logo embroidered on the left side of the T shirt.

Navy blue plain school cardigan or Jacket (winter uniform)

- PE uniform (T shirt with round collar and black jogger pants with blue stripes on sides.
- Brown or black formal shoes with white socks.

Girls

- Navy blue full length pinafore with embroidered Al Madina logo.
- Whit polo T shirt with navy blue stripe in collar and cuff and embroidered Al Madina logo on the left side.
- PE uniform (T shirt with round collar and black jogger pants with pink stripes on sides.
- White Hijab (if the parent wants her to wear hijab).

- Navy blue plain school cardigan (winter uniform).
- Black long leggings (Cotton).
- Brown, black or white formal shoes with white socks.

Important note to all Students:

- Hair styles must be appropriate for school (boys must not have long hair).
- Coats and caps must not be worn inside school buildings or classroom.
- Daily uniform checks will be carried out and children coming to school without school uniform must be issued with a warning and parents must be contacted.

Role of the Class Teachers / subject teachers and Support Staff

- Set a good example in terms of dress.
- To remind children to wear school uniform.
- The class teacher should speak to children who do not wear the correct uniform. If they still are not wearing the uniform they are to be referred to the Head of the School.

Role of the Head of School

- The Head of School is to ensure that pupils comply with the uniform policy.
- The Head of School has a right to enforce the school uniform throughout the school community, as part of the duty within maintenance of day to day discipline in the school.
- The Head of School will contact the parents of children who persistently do not wear the correct uniform.

Role of the Parents/Guardians

- To ensure that their child / children adhere to the school's uniform policy.
- Ensure that they come to school in uniform everyday unless there are special circumstances such as non-uniform days.
- To ensure that the uniform is clean, washed and neatly ironed.
